

NORTH BATTLEFORD BONSPIEL IS OVER

**B. Anderson, of Saskatoon,
Won Two Open Events and
the Grand Aggregate**

NORTH BATTLEFORD, Sask., Feb. 20.—After several interruptions owing to very mild weather the North Battleford bonspiel was brought to a close Saturday shortly before midnight. C. B. Anderson, of Saskatoon, carried off the honors of the 'spiel by winning the Grand Challenge and Merchants' Cup, two open events, and obtained the Grand Aggregate.

He, however, went down to defeat in the final of the Foley Cup to E. Gosnell, of North Battleford.

Gosnell also figured in the final of the President's Cup, being defeated by H. Hacker, of Vegreville.

The Citizens' Cup was won by A. F. Benard, of North Battleford, who defeated N. T. Brown, of Old Battleford.
