

# Granite Curling Club

## Information and Program Season 1958-59

### MEN'S SECTION

1. Sixty rinks only will be accommodated in the regular club schedule.
2. Until November 15th, 1958, priority will be given to applicants from those rinks whose personnel includes four members in good standing from last season.
3. All rink applications must state the names of the four players making up the rink. In the event of a resignation of one or more players from a rink following the opening of the season's play, replacement as required may be made with the approval of the management.
4. Individual applications for membership are welcome. The management will make every effort to place applicants whenever and wherever possible.
5. We will accept membership for the Spare Board. A "winterfull" of curling and good fun is assured.
6. The draws during the week will be at 7:00 p.m. and 9:00 p.m., Monday through Friday. All rinks will have a minimum of two games weekly in a progressive - demotion type of schedule. In this schedule there will be at least 30 games, with the opening qualifying rounds commencing immediately following the harvest spiel (approximately Nov. 15, 1958).
7. Whenever the ice is not occupied by bonspiels, or league play, it will be available to members by arrangement of the manager, for scratch games, practice, club competitions, etc. — all without extra charges.
8. Men's Fees: Shareholders ..... \$30.00

     Brooms supplied — no charge.

### Commercial League Curling

1. Last season's commercial leagues will be given priority until November 8th, 1958, to reserve ice for this season. Should any vacancies exist following this date, new applications will be considered in order of receipt.
2. The management will assist in organizing any leagues for individuals who are unable to establish their own. Accommodation is limited to 14 teams in each league.
3. Members of commercial leagues will be able to participate in local annual bonspiel at the same rate as regular club members.
4. Commercial Fees: \$1.00 per game, minimum of \$12.00 per season. Playoff games and brooms at no extra charge.
5. Bonspiels: \$5.00 per sheet per 2-hour draw. Reservations must be made with the manager.
6. Non-member scratch games: \$1.00 per person — \$6.00 per game.
